From day one, she received a warm welcome and support from our town and never looked back. It wasn't long before she met her Canadian spouse. Together for 30 years, they raised five wonderful children and eight amazing grandchildren.

For twenty-seven years, they dedicated themselves to running a business before they decided to sell and retire. In 2019, they registered with Seniors at Home (SAH) to give back to their community who had been so supportive of them over the years.

Unfortunately, the universe had different plans thanks to Covid19. After contracting the virus, dashing their initial hopes of volunteering, this couple eventually became active volunteers

offering companionship through our Friendly Visiting/Caller program. She's also known to share homemade scones and swapping plants with a few of clients! Between the two, this couple also volunteer their time to the Income Tax Clinic.

When asked about volunteering, this couple encourages others to consider the fulfilling path of volunteering. In her own words, "If you discover that you have some spare time in your daily life, consider volunteering. You will not regret it".
