

It's almost that time! Our Community Volunteer Income Tax Program, in collaboration with Canada Revenue Agency will soon be available to individuals with low to

modest income for those with a "**simple**" tax situation, i.e. no self-employment or business income or expenses, no capital gains or losses or bankruptcy files.

We will be open to accept 2024 Income Tax forms beginning March 3, 2025, until April 30, 2025. This service is offered BY APPOINTMENT ONLY from our office located at 106 McGonigal Street West, Arnprior on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays between the hours of 10:00am and 2:00pm. Service will be provided through our convenient drop-off window.

The Income Tax Program is FREE of charge. However, as a non-profit charitable organization, donations are appreciated to help with various agency programming costs. In return, you will be issued an official charitable donation receipt for income tax purposes (2025).
